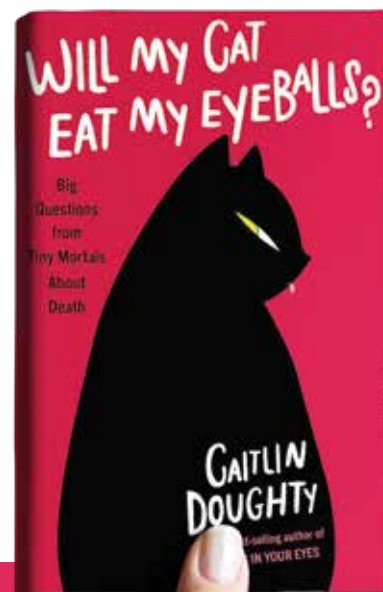
What happens if someone dies on a plane?
