Reagan's career began in beauty and makeup and, whilst driving home one day, she decided that she would prefer to put her skills to use on the deceased as a funeral cosmetologist.

Each podcast episode follows Reagan as she explains what inspired her career change, and what a day in the life of a young female funeral director is really like, revealing some popular misconceptions about what her role entails.
